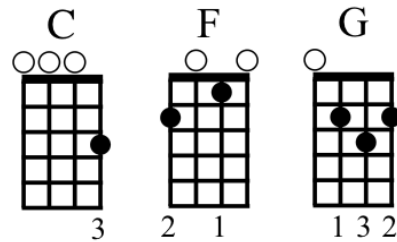


Leaving On a Jet Plane *John Denver*

Oh babe I hate to go.

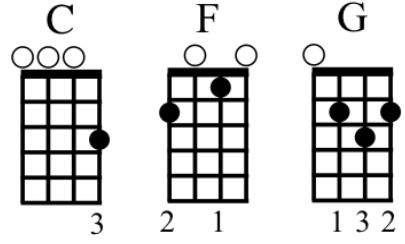
